Re: Disclosure Statements

Utah Code State code §17-16a-1-12 establishes standards of conduct for county officers and employees requiring these persons to disclose conflicts of interest between their public duties and their personal interests. The statement and disclosure shall contain the following information:

- Name and address of the officer;
- Name and address of the person or business entity being or to be assisted, or in which the appointed or elected official has a substantial interest; and
- A brief description of the transaction as to which service is rendered or is to be rendered and of the nature of the service performed or to be performed.

A new disclosure statement will need to be filed with the County 10 days prior to the date of any agreement between a county officer and the person or business entity being assisted or 10 days prior to the receipt of compensation by the business entity.

To meet these requirements please find attached disclosure statements from the Summit County elected officials and department heads.
