SUBJECT: Sundance Transportation and Pedestrian Operations

Requested Council Action

None. The purpose of this work session is information sharing.

Festival Operations

Park City Municipal has divided their operations activities into a three-pronged approach, including: Parking - free, remote parking with transit access and increased or additional transit service and paid parking; vehicle-for-hire staging areas; and contracted parking and pedestrian activity enforcement.

Free parking with enhanced transit service available at:

- 1/18/18 – 1/27/18: Richardson Flat Park and Ride Lot, transit service from 7 AM to 2:30 AM (Sundance operated)
- Park City Base, Canyons Village, Deer Valley Resort, transit service all Festival days from 4 PM to 2 AM
- McPolin Elementary, Treasure Mountain Middle School, and the Learning Center, weekends only with service at designated Sundance stops or regular transit service at Park City Transit stops
- Main Street employees only at Homestake lot, noon to 4 AM daily, with 10-minute shuttle service

Paid parking and other parking restrictions

- China Bridge - Parking is \$8 per hour/\$60 max rate
- Flagpole – Parking is \$40 flat rate (long term parking)
- Sandridge North – Carpool permit holders
- Sandridge South – Free parking (residential only)
- Main Street west side – Remove Parking on **Tuesday, January 16**
- All of Main Street – Removed parking on **Thursday, January 18**
- North Marsac and Gateway – Blue Permits only
- Brew Pub – City Operations (snow, taxi and communications) and ADA Parking
- Bob Wells Plaza – Closed **January 14 to January 29** for Festival Village
- 5th Street – Remain open, with Post Office parking
- 4th Street – Remain open, no Fire staging



For Hire Staging

- Lyft (Official Sponsor) staging at Old Clinic and on Swede behind Dolly's (must have Lyft decal)
- For Hire staging at Lower Main west side from bridge to 9th Street, 9th Street turn around and in Brew Pub. Staging in front of Post Office staging after 8 PM daily (must have Park City License Decal)

Transit Service

Park City Transit will operate on its normal winter schedule, with service between Park City and Kimball Junction generally provided from 7 AM to midnight, daily. Sundance has contracted with LeBus to provide free, supplemental shuttle service between venues, with five distinct shuttle routes.

Increased Enforcement Staffing

Park City Municipal has contracted with Kane Security to provide residential parking enforcement, taxi enforcement, and pedestrian management throughout the Festival.
