PROCLAMATION DECLARING FEBRUARY 14, 2018

**“National Donor Day in Honor of
Bayley Jayce Zollinger Huerta”**

SUMMIT COUNTY, UTAH

Whereas, Bayley Jayce Zollinger Huerta was born on May 19, 1994, the first of four children born to Lance Richard Zollinger and Diane Coleman Zollinger.

Whereas, Bayley married her high school sweetheart, Fernando Saul Heurta, June 26, 2015.

Whereas, Bayley and Fernando announced to their families in October of 2016 that they would be welcoming a baby girl, Elenna Grace, to their family in March of 2017.

Whereas, on December 17, 2016, Bayley was involved in a tragic car accident in central Utah, which claimed her life and the life of her unborn baby girl.

Whereas, Bayley is described as an angel in this life to all with whom she interacted, someone who loved to serve others and had a special gift in working with children.

Whereas, when the decision was made to donate Bayley’s organs Anita Lewis of Summit County became the recipient of Bayley’s liver.

Whereas, The Organ Procurement and Transplantation Network reports 33,611 transplants were performed in 2016.

Whereas, more than 116,000 men, women and children were on the national transplant waiting list as of August 2017.

Whereas, we commend Bayley for choosing to be a donor and therefore contributing to the 33,611 transplants that were performed the year she passed away.

Now, therefore, be it resolved the County Council, Summit County, Utah, does hereby declare February 14, 2018 as National Donor Day in Honor of Bayley Jayce Zollinger Huerta.
