PROCLAMATION DECLARING MAY 2018

“Older Americans Month”

SUMMIT COUNTY, UTAH

Whereas, Summit County serves congregate meals at the three senior centers within Summit County located in Coalville, Kamas, and Park City.

Whereas, each senior center is open two days a week offering a meal for those age 60 and over at a suggested donation of \$3.00 per person.

Whereas, the three centers serve an average of 223 meals a month to residents ages 60 and above.

Whereas, Summit County offers senior citizen residents an opportunity to request rides from volunteers to medical appointments.

Whereas, approximately eleven percent of Summit County residents are ages 60 or older.

Whereas, approximately three percent of Summit County’s senior citizen residents are veterans.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Summit County Council does hereby proclaim May 2018 as Older Americans Month and encourages Summit County citizens to remember the positive impacts on our community from the residents who helped shaped this county into what it is today.
