In response to the July 11, 2018 official notice of vacancy of the Summit County Recorder/Surveyor office, the Summit County Democratic Party has now completed the nomination and selection process for the vacant County Recorder/Surveyor position. The Summit County Democratic Party Central Committee met on July 26, 2018 to consider the remaining candidate, Rhonda Francis, who applied for the County Recorder/Surveyor office. Although there had been two candidates who initially declared their interest in the position, M. Alex Natt withdrew his candidacy on July 24, 2018.

In accordance with Party Bylaws, the Summit County Democratic Party Central Committee has completed the selection of the interim Summit County Recorder/Surveyor who will serve through Dec. 31, 2018. Per Utah Election Code Section 20A-1-508 (3)(b)(ii), as Party Liaison, I hereby submit Rhonda Francis to be the interim Summit County Recorder/Surveyor.

In addition, the Summit County Democratic Party Central Committee has certified Rhonda Francis to be the Democratic Candidate for Summit County Recorder/Surveyor for the 2018 November General Election ballot.
