AMENDMENT TO THE SNYDERVILLE BASIN DEVELOPMENT CODE

Public notice is hereby given that the Summit County Council in accordance with Section 10-9-18 of the Snyderville Basin Development Code will conduct a public hearing to review and possibly take action on amendments to Sections 10-2-4 Rural Residential (RR), 10-2-5 Hillside Stewardship (HS), 10-2-6 Mountain Remote (MR) and 10-11-1 Terms Defined of the Snyderville Basin Development Code. The purpose of the amendments is to modify setback requirements and create definitions for lakes, ponds, rivers, and streams in the residential zones.

Tuesday, February 8, 2023, beginning at 6 p.m.
