Public notice is hereby given that the Summit County Council in accordance with section 10-3-19 of the Snyderville Basin Development Code will conduct a public hearing to discuss and possibly take action on a Canyons Development Agreement Amendment for the Colony development amenities and support facilities. The applicants are requesting an amendment to the Colony Specially Planned Area and Development Agreement in order to allow for 61,278 sq. ft. of density on certain parcels within the Colony Development. Uses include, but are not specifically limited to employee housing to private maintenance facilities and private HOA lodge facilities which include dining, tennis courts, pool facility, and other amenities.
