TRANSPORTATION IMPACT FEE ANALYSIS FOR SUMMIT COUNTY

Pursuant to the provisions of Sections 11-36a-504 of the Utah Code, as amended, Summit County, a political subdivision of the State of Utah seeks public comment related to its draft Transportation Impact Fee Analysis and associated enabling ordinance. Summit County intends to adopt transportation impact fees for all of unincorporated Summit County (and in doing so, amend the existing Snyderville Basin transportation Impact Fees).
