### **SUMMIT COUNTY RESOURCE MANAGEMENT PLAN UPDATES AND AMENDMENTS AS REQUIRED BY HB160**

Public notice is hereby given that the Snyderville Basin Planning Commission, in accordance with section 10-7-2 of the Snyderville Basin Development Code will conduct a public hearing to discuss and possibly make a recommendation to the Summit County Council regarding the adoption of updates and amendments to the Summit County Resource Management Plan. The purpose of the updates and amendment is to comply with HB160 requirements related to land access, energy resources (including renewable energy), and mining and mineral resources (including critical minerals), as will add two new sections on utility corridors and pipelines, and infrastructure. Changes may affect the technical appendix referenced within the Snyderville Basin General Plan.
