**Chalk Creek Run Rezone and Master Planned Development (5-Lots)
Parcels CCRKR-1 (9.46 acres) and CCRKR-2 (3.90 acres), located 660 E Chalk Creek Road,
Coalville, Summit County, UT**

Public notice is hereby given that the Eastern Summit County Planning Commission in accordance with the Eastern Summit County Development Code will discuss and possibly take action on a Rezone and 5-lot Master Planned Development. The applicant is requesting to rezone and subdivide Parcels CCRKR-1 (9.46 acres) and CCRKR-2 (3.90 acres) into 5 lots total. Parcels CCRKR-1 (9.46 acres) and CCRKR-2 (3.90 acres) are in the AG-5 Zone. The applicant is proposing to rezone the properties to R-2.5 Zone in order to further subdivide the Chalk Creek Run Subdivision. In order to be approved, the applicant will need to rezone the properties from AG-5 to R-2.5 zone and will need to complete the MPD process. Should the rezone be approved, the applicant would qualify for three additional lots (5 lots total) in the subdivision.
