



## PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE

### EASTERN SUMMIT COUNTY DEVELOPMENT CODE AMENDMENTS

Public notice is hereby given that the Eastern Summit County Planning Commission in accordance with Section 11-5 of the Eastern Summit County Development Code will conduct a public hearing and possibly take action on amendments to Title 11 Eastern Summit County Development Code Chapter 8 Engineering Standards Section D (9-3-1 through 9-3-12: Title 9 Building Codes and Construction Chapter 3 Stormwater Pollution Prevention and Erosion Control) and Section E (4-5-1 through 4-5-19 Title 4 Health and Sanitation Chapter 5 Nonstormwater Discharges). The purpose of these updates is to bring the Code into compliance with Summit County's MS4 Permit. A recent audit of Summit County's MS4 program by the State of Utah's Division of Water Quality (DWQ) found these changes are required for Summit County to comply and avoid fines from the State. The changes have been approved by the DWQ.

The Commission will meet on **Thursday September 15, 2022, beginning at 6:00**, electronically, via zoom.

If you prefer, County staff will be available, in person, at the anchor location which is the Ledges Event Center, (202 East Park Road, Coalville, Utah 84017) to assist you in viewing the meeting and providing comments.
