



COVID-19 Vaccine Info (2/22/21)

Estimates are subject to change based on vaccine availability

- As of Feb 18, 2021, we have begun scheduling the age 65+ population for the COVID-19 vaccine. Anyone age 65 years or older with a Summit County address is eligible to receive a vaccine in Summit County. Please sign up at summitcounty.health.org/vaccine.

****NOTE:** Due to vaccine supply, it may take a few weeks before you receive your invitation to register for a vaccine appointment after you sign up on our website. Summit County is experiencing a higher demand for the vaccine than in other communities in the state. We are delivering vaccines as quickly as we receive them but due to the high demand, it is often taking longer than expected to get to everyone who is eligible.

- If you know someone who is age 65+ and lives in Summit County, please check that they are registered for the vaccine! If they are not, have them call
- If you received your first dose in Summit County, starting March 1, 2021 you will receive your second dose also at the Utah Film Studio and schedule it through the same vaccine administration management system (VAMS) you used to schedule your first vaccination. 435-333-0050 to get registered.
- If you received your first dose in Summit County, starting March 1, 2021 you will receive your second dose also at the Utah Film Studio and schedule it through the same vaccine administration management system (VAMS) you used to schedule your first vaccination.
- If you received your first dose at a location outside of Summit County (i.e. another county or another state), you need to return to that same location to receive your second dose. Your second dose will be shipped to that location. If you then get your second dose in Summit County you are taking a first dose from someone who needs it and it throws our entire vaccine inventory off. We are strictly adhering to this policy and people will be turned away from the clinic or their second dose appointment canceled if they received their first dose somewhere outside of Summit County.
- Starting March 1, individuals 18 - 64 years of age with specific health conditions are eligible for the COVID-19 vaccine in Utah. Go to summitcountyhealth.org/vaccine for a list of those medical conditions.

Registration for individuals 70+

1. Sign up at summitcountyhealth.org/vaccine or by calling 435-333-0050 (* Call if you don't use email or have an email address)
2. You will be notified by email or phone when appointment scheduling opens for you. We will never ask for your social security number, driver's license number, or bank account information.
3. When it is your turn to schedule a vaccination appointment, you will receive an email from the CDC that looks like the example below. If you don't use email, we will call to set your appointment.

NOTE: When registering with the CDC email, be sure to answer “no” to the very first question which states, “Have you already registered in VAMS?”
