PROCLAMATION RECOGNIZING
Doug Clyde
FOR 6 YEARS OF SERVICE ON THE SUMMIT COUNTY COUNCIL
SUMMIT COUNTY, UTAH

Whereas, Doug Clyde is a 44-year resident of Summit County and lives in Oakley with his wife, Melissa Caffey; and

Whereas, Doug moved to Park City in 1978 as a manager with Alpine of Tahoe, then owners of Park City Mountain Resort; and

Whereas, Doug has been a prominent figure in the Summit County and Park City development and recreation industries for over 40 years, including working as an executive in the mountain resort industry and as an independent consultant on some of the area's largest projects, including Empire Pass, Montage, and the base of Park City Mountain Resort; and

Whereas, Doug helped build the current Peace House domestic violence shelter, worked with Bill White Farms, and spearheaded resort-related projects in the Lake Tahoe Basin; and

Whereas, Doug was elected to the Summit County Council in 2016 and sworn into office in January 2017 after serving on the Eastern Summit County Planning Commission; and

Whereas, He is passionate about water quality and land use and has become an expert on issues involving riparian and sensitive lands with an unwavering commitment to decreasing sprawl, reducing traffic, improving transit, and keeping Summit County's air and water clean; and

Whereas, Doug brought to Council decision-making this expertise, informing Summit County's general plans, development codes, and land use decisions, at great benefit to the overall community; and

Whereas, Doug served as Council Chair during the COVID-19 pandemic, responding to citizen concerns, supporting staff, and helping to lead the County through this crisis; and

Whereas, Doug retires from the Summit County Council on November 2, 2022, after six years of dedicated service; and

Whereas, Doug will be remembered for his colorful commentary on issues, his humor, and his commitment to preserving the agricultural heritage and rural nature of eastern Summit County and quality of life for Summit County residents; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Summit County Council does hereby recognize Doug Clyde for his six years of service on the Summit County Council, and thanks him for his tireless efforts to improve the health, safety, and welfare of the community, and celebrates his commitment to making Summit County an all-around better place for those who live and visit here.
