On November 17, 2016 the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in cooperation with the State of Utah Division of Emergency Management sent your community **preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps (FIRMs)** for Summit County, UT and Incorporated Areas for review and comment. You should have received two copies of the FIRMs and Flood Insurance Study (FIS) text sent to your community for review, along with a digital copy of all files.

The Utah Division of Emergency Management is planning to hold a Community Consultation Officers (CCO) Meeting to discuss this project. We will conduct this meeting along with representatives from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) Region VIII and AECOM, the study contractor for this effort.

The purpose of this meeting is to:

- Discuss the scope and history of the project
- Discuss the progress, remaining schedule, and upcoming steps
- Solicit community input and discuss the upcoming appeal and comment period

It is very important that a representative of your community attend the CCO Meeting and Public Open House. It is also important that information regarding the time and place of this meeting be disseminated so that community officials interested in the map revision results can attend. Please pass this message along to those that you feel would benefit from this meeting, including: Mayors, Commissioners, Council Members, Engineering and GIS Specialists, City and County Planners, Emergency Managers, and Floodplain Administrators.

Once you have entered the Summit County map, you are then able to search any address from there. Please note that only select areas in the County were restudied as part of this update.
